*Created in the early 1960s, the Coat of Arms of the City of Baie-Comeau is mainly reserved for historic and official purposes. The Coat of Arms is distinct from the city's Logo, which is a stylized starfish.*

*An anchor set on wavy lines symbolizes the sea and maritime commerce. The foreground depicts the topography of the North Shore, a Vert (green) segment symbolizing the forest resources surrounding the city.*

*The fess Gules (red) and fess Purpure (violet or brown) represent the Precambrian land formation and the vast potential of its mineral deposits.*

*The lightning flashes signify the region's hydroelectric power development, while the dominant star above proclaims Baie-Comeau's proud destiny assured through the realization of its power bestowed.*

*Below the shield, a scroll Argent (silver) is inscribed with the city's motto: "De puissance comblée" ("Of power bestowed").*
