

Created in the early 1960s, the Coat of Arms of the City of Baie-Comeau is mainly reserved for historic and official purposes. The Coat of Arms is distinct from the city's Logo, which is a stylized starfish.

An anchor set on wavy lines symbolizes the sea and maritime commerce. The foreground depicts the topography of the North Shore, a Vert (green) segment symbolizing the forest resources surrounding the city.

The fess Gules (red) and fess Purpure (violet or brown) represent the Precambrian land formation and the vast potential of its mineral deposits.

The lightning flashes signify the region's hydroelectric power development, while the dominant star above proclaims Baie-Comeau's proud destiny assured through the realization of its power bestowed.

Below the shield, a scroll Argent (silver) is inscribed with the city's motto: "De puissance comblée" ("Of power bestowed").
